Meeting Summary – February 2019

- The Rappahannock Coin Club met February 20 at Scafa's Italian Restaurant at 10349 Courthouse Road, Mill Garden Plaza, Spostylvania VA 22553. The February meeting was called to order by the club President Billy Hoovler at 7:33 pm. There were 22 members present and 1 guest. Greg Coburn, Treasurer, gave both the treasurer's report. The ending balance including the \$150 petty cash is \$3,356.37. Mark Entner gave the secretary's report of last meetings minutes. Both reports were approved and accepted by club vote.

- After conducting business (See Old and New Business Below) club members did a show and tell. Many wonderful things were shared with the Billy, and Jack won the encased coins.

• Old Business

Dues for the ANA were free because of the number of club members who are ANA members as well.

Billy brought up the RACC Medal of Merit idea again. There was several minutes of discussion before the club decided to have the Executive Board develop more details about the specifics of how the medal of merit is to be awarded.

As part of the May meeting, we will hold an Ugliest Coin Competition. This was also discussed with the decision that there will be no criteria but simply a vote by members. You can bring a coin that looks bad and used, or you can bring a nice coin but that the subject of the engraving is ugly.

• New Business

Bob Ayers of Bob's Coins, a regular dealer in Virginia, passed away. Club members signed a sympathy card. See the VNA posting about Bob.

Billy announced that there would be no EB this month.

Mark stirred things up by bringing a motion to the floor since there would be no EB. Mark motioned that since our club account balance was so high, and that we took in more at the Christmas dinner than we had spent, as an officer of the club, he moved that we suspend membership dues for the year. After discussion, the club approved the motion.

It was then moved that the club set aside a sum of \$250 dollars to supplement any club member who wanted to participate in the VNA show class. This year the subject is recognizing counterfeits. The \$250 will be split among members who take the class which itself usually costs \$250 - \$300 dollars.
