- There might be a silver rally underway! Silver has busted through the \$16 per ounce barrier and is now trading at \$16.30 which represents a six month high.
- The U.S. Mint's authorized buyers have purchased this week's entire 1,036,000ounce allocation of American Eagle Silver bullion coins in a three day period ending April 13th.
- The ANA is offering encapsulated Silver Eagles as part of a membership drive. A limited edition NGC MS69 Silver Eagle is offered for members joining at the Platinum level (\$46) or for existing members who renew for an additional 3 years. A limited edition NGC MS70 Silver Eagle for members joining with a lifetime membership (\$600 - \$1,200) – only 250 of these will be issued.
