Did You Know?

The US Mint released the 2016, Standing Liberty Quarter on September 8th, 2016. The coin is the second release in a three coin set 100 years in the making. Coin World wrote: "The 2016-W Standing Liberty gold quarter dollar will be struck on planchets composed of a quarter-ounce (7.776 grams) of .9999 fine gold. The weight and fineness are recorded on the coin's obverse, in two lines on the framed panel in the right field below WE TRVST, as AU 24K in the top line and 1/4 OZ. below. The coin will exhibit a circulation strike finish and bear a reeded edge. The gold coin's diameter is 0.866 inch, or 22 millimeters, and it is 0.064 inch or 1.63 millimeters thick." The Mint limited production to 100,000 and only 1 per household. They sell for \$485.00. As of 11 September, 2016 – They were still available for order – even though eBay has sold some as high as \$675.00
